Work varies dependent upon the Department, i.e., mow and trim grass, pull weeds, plant flowers, filling holes/cracks in City streets, delivering garbage carts, erecting and taking down mobile signs. (NOTE: If time is needed off work, it must be requested from the Supervisor in advance. If an employee calls in sick, medical documentation must be submitted for the sick leave to be approved.) Summer student employees must maintain the ability to lawfully operate designated motor vehicles at all times that duties are performed, and maintain the ability to travel throughout and enter all different properties in the jurisdiction.
