DID YOU KNOW?

ELECTRIC VEHICLES: SAFE CHARGING AND STORAGE

As municipalities seek to lower emissions and improve fuel economy, more electric vehicles (EVs) and hybrids are being added to fleets.

High-voltage lithium-ion batteries store electrical energy which may create unique fire and electrical hazards.

Considerations:

- If in an accident, an EV should be stored outside.
- Quarantine areas for EVs suspected to have a faulty or damaged battery.
- Charging areas should be outside and away from buildings.
- If charging inside, consider fire suppression or the actuation of fire detection systems.
- The charging area should have adequate ventilation and space.
